Three sources of Greek art: works themselves (small fraction of what once existed), Roman copies (could be an interpretation rather than a direct copy, or simply we do not know what the original looked like - we just have the copies), and literature. Greeks were the first western people to write at length about their art and artists.

Greek Art Artistic traditions of the ancient world focused on representing royal figures and divinities and on the function of funerary and palatial complexes within their cultural contexts. Works of art illustrate the active exchange of ideas and reception of artistic styles among the Mediterranean cultures

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and the subsequent influence on the classical world.

A kouros (pl. kouroi) is a standing male youth who represents the idea of youth and strength in Archaic Greece.
